Thank you for your continued support, patronage and patience throughout this ongoing pandemic.

We are pleased to announce that we will be reopening our indoor dining service. Beginning
Tuesday, March 30, we will open our indoor dining
service in addition to continuing with our outdoor
patio dining and takeout.

Lunch service 11:30am ~ 3:00pm (2:30 last call) Dinner service 5:00pm ~ 9:00pm (8:30 last call)

For your safety, as well as our staff's safety, we will be following the guidelines and regulations provided to us from the county. Please be prepared to follow the guidelines below. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding.

#### -Reservations-

- \*We encourage making reservations to ensure availability.
  Please make your plans accordingly and in advance.
- \*We will accept walk-in guests if there is availability, but there will be limitations due to fewer tables and no waiting spaces.
- \*Upon arrival, your entire party must be present in order to be seated.

(You will not be able to wait at your table for your party to arrive)

\* Your outdoor patio reservation may be subject to cancellation due to rain and/ or wind.

#### -Face Covering Requirement-

- \*Please only remove the mask while seated and dining. (When you are not seated at your table, ie. when you get up to use the restroom)
- \*Kids under the age of 2, or people with medical conditions that make wearing a face covering hazardous, are exempt.

#### -Temperature Checks-

- \*Upon arrival, we will check your temperature using a no-contact thermometer.
- \* If you have a temperature of 100.4 F or higher, we will not be able to accommodate you or anyone else in your party (since you have likely been in close contact).

#### -Party Size & Dining Time-

- \*We are only able to accommodate parties of 6 or less.
- \*We can seat up to 3 different households per table for outdoor dining.
- \*We can seat only 1 household per table for indoor dining.
- \*To ensure we have time to clean between reservations, and in order to provide proper social-distancing, we ask you to kindly limit your dining experience to a maximum of 2 hours.

#### -Dining with Children-

\*We love your kids, but please be sure to have them remain next to you at all times. Please make sure they avoid touching people that are not in your party, or items that do not belong to them.

### -Other Safety Measures-

- \* Hand Sanitizer will be available for use.
- \* If you have been in contact in the last 14 days with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please refrain from visiting until a further date.
- \*Outdoor patio dining can be very cold at times. Please dress warm and bring a blanket for yourself.

## -The Health of Our Staff-Our Staff is also being monitored and taking precautionary measures for your safety.

\*Conducting frequent hand washing and sanitizing

\*Wearing a face covering/ mask at all times

\*Sanitizing surfaces and frequent cleaning

\*Staff members with potential symptoms, or those who have potentially come in contact with somebody who has contracted COVID-19, are asked to stay home for 14 days.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation while we navigate these adjustments.

For guests who prefer takeout, we will still be continuing with our takeout service with our exclusive takeout menu from 11:30am- 8:30pm
